THEY DIED IN CUSTODY

On Thursday, 16th July 2009, R. Gunasegaran, died at the hands of police in Sentul and Teoh Beng Hock died at the hands of Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) in Shah Alam. Since that Thursday, thousands of people have died in custody..

EDICT alone received 25 cases of deaths in custody since early 2020.

According to parliamentary answers by the Home Minister on 30th March 2017, there are 110 deaths in police lockup and 1619 deaths in prison between 2010 to 2016.

Between 2013-2017, Home Minister also revealed, there are 1293 deaths in prison, and 140 deaths in police lockup.
