



Gabungan Bertindak Malaysia (GBM) adalah gabungan dua puluh lima (25) buah Badan-badan Bukan Kerajaan berbagai ethnic dan agama, tidak memihak dan bertekad untuk membangun Malaysia yang lebih baik.

Memandangkan PRU 13 adalah persimpangan bersejarah dalam perjalanan negara kita menuju penghayatan demokrasi yang teguh dan matang; Kami menyeru semua parti-parti politik agar:

- i. menghormati hasrat rakyat mahukan pilihanraya yang bebas, adil dan bersih yang mematuhi prinsip-prinsip dan proses demokrasi;
- ii. berkempen berasaskan polisi dan program yang bermanfaat kepada rakyat dan negara dan bukan berasaskan kutuk-mengutuk;

iii. berjanji untuk tidak memutarbelit isu-isu berkaitan agama, kaum, kecenderungan seksual dan kepercayaan; dan

iv. mengutuk dan menghindar dari melakukan sebarang tindakan keganasan politik.

Kami menyeru semua institusi kerajaan agar:

i. berpegang teguh kepada prinsip tidak memihak dan neutral seperti yang termaktub di dalam Perlembagaan Persekutuan;

ii. menyelia dan menjalankan pilihanraya secara bebas dan tidak memihak seperti yang dikehendaki oleh Perlembagaan dan Undang-undang yang berkuatkuasa (Suruhanjaya Pilihan Raya);

iii. mengamalkan piawai profesionalisme yang tertinggi dalam menguruskan urusan negara semasa fasa “kerajaan interim” dan dalam membantu Suruhanjaya Pilihan Raya menguruskan proses pilihanraya (Perkhimatan Awam dan Pasukan Keselamatan);

iv. berpegang teguh kepada prinsip pemisahan kuasa dan keadilan di dalam mengadili keskes berkaitan pelaksanaan dan keputusan pilihanraya;

v. menghormati keputusan pilihan yang dibuat oleh rakyat dan memastikan perpindahan kuasa yang aman pasca PRU 13. Pembentukan kerajaan baru hendaklah menurut semangat dan

matan Perlembagaan Persekutuan dan Perlembagaan Negeri masing-masing.

Kami menyeru media cetak dan elektronik agar melaporkan pilihanraya dengan adil dan bertanggungjawab serta berpegang teguh kepada piawai kewartawanan tertinggi sebagai mana yang dikehendaki oleh tatalaku profesion pengamal media.

Kami menggesa rakyat menggunakan hak yang diberi oleh perlembagaan untuk mengundi secara bertanggungjawab, serta menerima keputusan majoriti seperti yang ditetapkan di bawah sistem demokrasi berparlimen kita.

Memandangkan kesangsian yang timbul dari Siasatan Suruhanjaya Diraja di Sabah, kami menggesa SPR untuk mengundang pemantau pilihanraya yang ditauliahkan oleh Bangsa-bangsa Bersatu dan Komanwel. Kami percaya ini akan memulihkan keyakinan rakyat yang pilihanraya ini adalah bebas, adil dan bersih. Ia juga akan melonjakkan imej Malaysia dimata masyarakat antarabangsa.

Akhir sekali kami mengingatkan bahawa pengamalan demokrasi yang baik tidak berakhir pada

hari mengundi. Rakyat mesti terus memainkan tanggungjawab menentukan masa depan kita. Kerajaan dan parti-parti politik mesti dituntut menepati janji-janji pilihanraya mereka. Sehubungan ini GBM menyeru agar semua pihak giat mengadakan syura supaya amalan demokrasi kita menjadi lebih mantap.

Fully cognizant that the General Election 13 represents a historic crossroad in our Nation's journey to become a viable and mature democratic polity;

We call upon all Political Parties:-

i. To respect the People's desire to have free, fair and clean elections and to uphold the principles and processes of democratic elections;

ii. To campaign on the basis of policies and programmes that will benefit the Rakyat and the Nation, and not on the basis of maligning each other;

iii. To pledge not to manipulate and exploit issues pertaining to religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation and creed; and

iv. To condemn and refrain from any acts of political violence.

We call upon all Institutions of State:-

i. To uphold the principles of impartiality and neutrality as enshrined in the Federal Constitution;

ii. To oversee and conduct the elections in an independent and non-partisan manner as prescribed by the Constitution and legislation in force (Election Commission);

iii. To adhere to the highest standards of professionalism in managing the affairs of the Nation during the 'Interim government' phase, and in assisting the Election Commission to manage the electoral processes (Public Services and Security Forces);

iv. To uphold the cardinal principle of separation of powers in adjudicating on cases pertaining to the conduct and outcomes of the elections, without fear or favour (Judiciary);

v. To respect the verdict of the People and to ensure a peaceful transfer of power post GE 13. The formation of a new government(s) must adhere to the spirit and letter of the Federal Constitution and respective State Constitutions.

We call upon the print and electronic Media to report on the elections in a fair and responsible manner and adhere to the highest standards of journalism as prescribed by the code of conduct of the profession.

We urge the People to exercise their constitutional right to vote responsibly, and to accept the verdict of the majority as prescribed under our system of parliamentary democracy.

Taking into cognisance, the doubts created in the minds of the people resulting from the on-going RCI hearings in Sabah, we call upon the EC to invite the United Nation and the Commonwealth accredited observers. We believe this will restore the confidence of the people in the free, fair and clean electoral process, as well as boost the image of Malaysia in the eyes of the world community.

Finally, we must be conscious that a functioning, viable democracy does not end with the election day. The people must take responsibility of our future and hold the government and political parties responsible to honour the promises made during the Elections. In this regard, GBM calls upon all stakeholders to engage in regular consultation to uphold our cherished democracy.
